POLICY TITLE: ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE - STUDENTS

The Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science is cognizant of difficulty that students with English as a second language (ESL) may incur in the program. Any student identified with ESL will be accommodated in as much as the college is capable. The student's ESL issues must not prohibit the student from meeting the course objectives.

PROCEDURE:

1. Students with English as a second language may be identified by the Admissions staff through admission data, or by faculty, such as education history and application data.
2. Their names will be given to Dean of Academic Affairs (DAA).
3. The DAA will meet with the student to discuss possible accommodations.
4. DAA will discuss accommodations with appropriate Student Services Staff, Department Chairs and Faculty.
5. Student will be directed to contact the appropriate Student Services staff, the appropriate Department Chair and Faculty regarding the accommodations.
6. If the student makes appropriate contact, accommodations will be implemented.
7. If the student does not make appropriate contact, accommodations will not be implemented.
