Student Advisory Council

The Student Advisory Council is a standing committee of Good Samaritan College Assembly. The six at large Student Representatives will be elected yearly.

- a. **Purpose**
Provide a vehicle for the student body representatives and college administration to communicate formally about relevant campus issues and concerns, ideas, and suggestions.

- b. **Functions**
 1. Provide an official channel of communication and cooperation between students and college administration.
 2. College administration seek student input and share issues of mutual interests that includes but not limited academic programs, non-curricular programs, student services, campus facilities, and policies and procedures with direct impact on students.
 3. Submit reports and recommendations to the President and to College Assembly and its respective standing committees as appropriate.

Six at large elected Student representatives
