

## Good Samaritan College Partnership with Chatfield College

This articulation agreement is designed to coordinate transfer policies, enhance advising, and promote the acceptance of the transfer of associate degree credit from the Chatfield College (CC) to Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science (GSC). Students who qualify are exempt from paying the GSC application fee. The maximum number of transfer credits accepted from Chatfield College (CC) will have a C or better grade and will be equal to 25 semester credit hours. If you are a transfer student from Chatfield College, inquire with GSC Admission staff regarding this agreement.

### **GSC accepts credits from Chatfield**

GSC will accept applications from students who wish to transfer from Chatfield College into any related pre-licensure associate degree program at GSC. Transferring CC applicants must meet the same admissions criteria as other students applying for transfer to GSC. There is no application fee.

CC students will be required to meet all prerequisite requirements at GSC prior to acceptance. Once admitted, students are subject to all other policies and procedures, including residency requirement of GSC, as outlined in the GSC catalog. Students who have questions may consult with a counselor and/or advisor at either institution for assistance. There is no reciprocal agreement at this time with Chatfield.

### **What credits articulate through this agreement?**

The maximum number of transfer credits accepted from CC will be equal to 25 semester credit hours. Under this agreement, all courses required to complete the specific related associate's degree program will be transferred into the pre-licensure associate's program in their entirety. "C-" grades or below, will not transfer in, allowing the student to complete their related degree program at GSC.

GSC will evaluate courses/credits earned through Advanced Placement (AP), College-Level Examination Program (CLEP), or other testing programs. GSC also will evaluate courses/credits earned at other institutions. Students seeking credit for these courses must provide the college with official transcripts for evaluation.

### **Is there a time limit for CC students to transfer to GSC?**

The curriculum in effect at the time a student first enrolls at CC will be honored by GSC if the student successfully transfers to GSC within 10 years of that first enrollment at CC. Exceptions can be made by the Registrar's Office in consultation with appropriate department chairs.
