November 1<sup>st</sup> marks the 125<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Good Samaritan College of Nursing and Health Science. In 1896, the Good Samaritan Hospital School of Nursing two-year program was started by the Sisters of Charity. Eight students started in the program and the curriculum included surgery, bacteriology, massage, bandaging and nursing ethics. Today, the college offers degrees in three programs: Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AASN); Associate of Science in Health Science (ASHS); Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN to BSN),

as well as certificate programs for medical assisting and pharmacy technician and we have over 6000 alumni. Our original motto, "go where you are needed" is still true today, as our students and graduates compassionately care for our community where they are needed, 125 years later.
