## Minimum Requirements for Program Admission

- High School GPA or cumulative college GPA of 2.0 or higher (applicants with a GED must meet the minimum score of at least 2250 and have no scores lower than 410 in individual sections)
- One of the following
  - ACT score of 17 or higher or SAT score of 1210 (scores valid for two years)
  - Accuplacer reading score of 236 and arithmetic score of 200 (or higher)
  - Earned degree from accredited institution with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 (or higher)
  - Earned 15 or more credit hours from a CHEA or USDE organization
